We designed the **CMC Radio Holster** for circumstances when a radio chest harness interferes with backpack straps or a full body harness. It is designed to hold the radio securely to a shoulder strap allowing the same access as our Radio Harnesses while maintaining a low profile. The incorporated belt loop for hanging the radio accommodates most belts. The pocket for the radio utilizes the same design that has been proven on the **CMC Radio Harness**.

The pocket for the radio should be adjusted to fit as tight as possible. To adjust the height of the pocket, insert the included tongue depressor (or other flat surface) alongside the bottom strap to separate the hook and loop surfaces. Adjust for the proper height with the plastic buckle just above the top edge of the pocket. Remove the tongue depressor and check to make sure the bottom strap is secure. The shock cord retaining strap was selected because it does not interfere with the control knobs and buttons found on today's more sophisticated handheld radios. Place the radio antenna through the shock cord to secure the radio while inverted.

The hook and loop attachment straps should be tightened as much as possible around the shoulder strap to hold the radio securely. When using the Radio Holster with a CMC full body harness that has a mesh vest, the mesh can be folded around the harness shoulder webbing to make the Radio Holster fit.

CARRYING, MAINTENANCE & STORAGE

During use, carrying and storage keep the equipment away from acids, alkalis, exhaust emissions, rust and strong chemicals. Do not expose the equipment to flame or high temperatures. Carry the equipment where it will be protected as the equipment could melt or burn and fail if exposed to flame or high temperatures.

If the equipment becomes soiled, it can be washed in cold water with a mild detergent that is safe for use with nylon and polyester. Dry out of direct sunlight. Do not dry in an automatic dryer. Store in a cool, dry location. Do not store where the equipment may be exposed to moist air, particularly where dissimilar metals are stored together.
